If your landlord has a HUD (including FHA), USDA, VA, Fannie Mae, or Freddie Mac mortgage:

Evictions for nonpayment, notices to vacate, and late fees are banned for 120 days - until July 25 by the federal stimulus (CARES) Act. After that, 30 days' notice is required.

It is illegal for your landlord to put you out without an eviction judgment from a court! If this happens to you, or if your landlord gives you an eviction notice while evictions are banned, call a lawyer.
